

## 22<sup>nd</sup> annual Festival in the Park Juried Art Show

The Festival in the Park is a one day juried art exhibition presented by the Lachenmeyer Arts Center. The exhibit will take place on Saturday, October 9, 2010, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Memorial Park in Cushing, OK. This event includes live entertainment all day, a 5K Run, Chili cook off, children's activities, food booths and more. The Festival in the Park is sponsored by the Cushing Chamber of Commerce & Industry & the Lachenmeyer Arts Center.

Festival artists will be provided breakfast from Cushing McDonald's.



**Catergories:** The three categories are two dimensional works on canvas, two dimensional works on paper and all three dimensional work.

**Awards:** There will be one Best of Show for \$200, three first place awards of \$100 each, three second place awards of \$75 and three third place awards of \$50.

**Artist choice award:** Oklahoma artist Dale Martin has donated \$200 for the artist choice award. This award will be determined by the registered Festival artists.

**Purchase awards:** In addition to cash awards, purchase awards are sold prior to the Festival to guarantee sales to the artists. In 2009 we sold \$1875.00 in purchase awards to individuals and businesses in the Cushing community.

**Juror: Charleen Weidell** - Charleen Weidell is an Associate Professor of Jewelry & Metalsmithing and Department Chair for the Art Department, College of Fine Arts & Design at the University of Central Oklahoma, Edmond. She has an MFA in jewelry and metalsmithing from San Diego State University where she studied under renowned metal artists Helen Shirk and Arline Fisch. Charleen's work in metal has been exhibited and collected on the international, national and local levels. "Tart Server", a broad blade silver server, was recently published in "Contemporary Silver Part II: Recent Commissions" written by collector Seymour Rabinovich and acquired by the Victoria & Albert Museum in London, England.

**Eligibility:** The Festival in the Park is open to fine arts media. Each artist must submit three color slides or photographs that are representational of their work. A self addressed stamped envelope must be enclosed for the return of your slides or photographs. You may also list your web site instead of sending photographs or slides. All artwork must be the work of the individual artist. Work from molds or kits, manufactured or commercial items will not be accepted. T-shirts and wearable art may not be sold. Only original signed work will be accepted for judging.

### Booth fees:

**Type A** - A 10' x 10' space in Memorial Park is available for \$50. Artists are responsible for their own tent, tables and display panels.

**Type B** - A 10' x 10' covered space is available for \$60. We will place artists in the pavilion or under a tent. Artists are responsible for their own tables, chairs & display panels.

**Type C** - A 10' x 10' pavilion space with display panels is available for \$70. All pavilion spaces are available on a first come-early registration basis. Only eight panel spaces are available! Electricity is available in the pavilion only. Artists must bring their own extension cords and lighting.

All Art sales will be handled by the individual artists. No responsibility for theft or damage can be assumed by the Festival in the Park sponsors. Please make your check payable to the Lachenmeyer Arts Center. No refunds after October 1, 2010.
